## **GREENWALD:** **WE WILL NOT REPEAT LAST MINUTE REPUBLICAN** **FEEDING FRENZY**

(TRENTON) – Assembly Budget Chairman Lou Greenwald released the following statement today:

*“I am heartened by Gov. Corzine’s move to find \$400 million in budget savings and by the insistence by the Governor and Speaker Roberts that the Legislature not pass bills during the upcoming post-election session that would result in added spending.*

*“Post-election sessions are a time to tackle unfinished business, and under Speaker Roberts these sessions have been very moderate and measured.*

*“One thing we won’t do is repeat what happened in 2001, when Republicans went on a wild and chaotic feeding frenzy and at the last minute irresponsibly spent hundreds of millions of dollars we didn’t have as a recession loomed.*
